

The State Council of Heraldry at the Parliament of Georgia hereby applies for membership in the International Federation of Vexillological Associations (FIAV).

SCHG submits and commits itself to the FIAV purposes:

- to create strong bond among associations and institutions and to encourage and coordinate their work, studies, and research;
- to promote the organization of International Congresses of Vexillology and to lend its support to their organizers;
- to encourage the creation in all countries of associations and institutions dedicated to vexillology; and
- to sanction international standards facilitating the development of this activities.

I am sure, you know Georgia was a post-Soviet republic and we started from the beginning. But it is important to say Georgia has heraldry traditions and experience and our main purpose to restore and develop this.

The State Council of Heraldry at the Parliament Georgia has been founded in accordance of Georgian Parliament's № 5778-I-decision 29.02.08. We have statutes and structure which define our rights and incumbencies.

Firstly (1994) it was a commission of the President of Georgia, and at the beginning it was non-governmental, non-profit association.

At present the State Council of Heraldry regulates and settles national heraldry signs and symbols. We created flags, coat-of-arms symbols of cities, towns, regions municipalities. For example from 67 municipalities of Georgia 34 have already adopted and proved flags and arms. Here work well-known historians, heraldry specialists, jurist, designer and so on. Periodically we arrange exhibitions to show our works and hold seminars in regions for people to introduce some standards for creation flags and symbols. Just now we try to establish communications with different countries, our group works at our web-site www.heraldika.ge (English version in the spring) that will launch soon. We have a Facebook page (Heradry of Georgia) also.

The Rotterdam Flag Parade Foundation (in Dutch Stichting Vlaggenparade Rotterdam SVPR) hereby applies for the membership of the International Federation of Vexillological Associations (FIAV).

The SVPR has been established on November 26, 2007 in Rotterdam as a successor of the Rotterdam Flag Museum Foundation (in Dutch Stichting Vlaggenmuseum Rotterdam SVR, established June 6, 1997), together with the Netherlands Flag Museum Foundation (in Dutch Stichting Vlaggenmuseum Nederland SVN), a member of FIAV.

The SVPR is a non-governmental and non-profit foundation with the goal:

- a. to collect and expose flags and banners in flag parades in the Netherlands and elsewhere;
- b. to organize exhibitions and special events on flags and banners;
- to develop all activities which are related to the aforementioned.

The foundation has as primary goal to collect and expose flags and banners in one or more Flag Parades in the Netherlands and more specifically the management of the existing Rotterdam Flag Parade which consists of 230 flag poles with the illuminated flags of all the 170 nations represented in the Dutch population (as a "Welcome to the Netherlands") plus the 60 flags of the sponsors. This Rotterdam Flag Parade is used as well for special exhibitions and flag hoisting ceremonies and during special events.

The SVPR hereby formally commits itself to the FIAV purposes, as defined in Article 3 of its Constitution, namely

- to create a strong bond among those associations and institutions and to encourage and coordinate their work, studies and research:
- b. to promote periodically the organization of International Congresses of Vexillology and to lend its support to the organizers;
- c. to encourage the creation in all countries of associations and institutions dedicated to vexillology;
- d. to sanction international standards facilitating the development of these activities.

The SVPR is constituted in conformity with the laws of the Kingdom of the Netherlands. According to these, the SVPR is registered in the Register of Foundations and Associations of the Rotterdam Chamber of Commerce under the number 41136370. Following this the SVPR is registered as a business subject in relation to the Added Value Tax Law.

Enclosed you will find a copy of the SVPR Articles of Constitution (in Dutch). These define the goals, activities and bodies of the Foundation and its duties and rights.

The highest body of the foundation is the Board, consisting of the President, the Vice-President, the Treasurer, the Secretary and two ordinary members.

The SVPR maintains a website at www.vlaggenparade.nl through which the public, the sponsors and the media are informed on all the news in the field of flags, banners and flag parades in the Netherlands and abroad, on the news in the Foundation and in comparable associations and institutions in the Netherlands and abroad and on all related issues with special attention to flag parades.

The SVPR published 3 times a year a bulletin named "Vlaggenlijn" (Flagline) in cooperation with the Netherlands Flag Museum Foundation. "Flagline"contained articles on various aspects of the vexillological world and on the history of flags, the flags of new countries and on Flag Parades. This publication merged with the Bulletin "Vexilla Nostra" of the (FIAV member) Nederlandse Vereniging voor Vlaggenkunde (Netherlands Vexillological Association NVvV). The new magazine VLAG! has since 2008 continued the highly informative and scientific contents of its predecessors.

The SVPR maintains close relations with the Netherlands Flag Museum Foundation, the Netherlands Vexillological Association, the Netherlands Supreme Council of Nobility, as well as with a number of Dutch Ministries and educational institutions, with the Rotterdam Town Council and its Burgomaster.

The SVPR is in contact with related institutions in the world through personal contacts of the Board Members, exchange of ideas and publications and occasional visits. Two Board members attended the FIAV International Congress of Vexillology in Berlin in 2007 and two Board members attended as authorized representatives the FIAV-Congress and General Assembly in Yokohama in 2009.

STATUTE

of "Macedonian Heraldry Society" Inc.

Article 1

The Macedonian Heraldry Society is a voluntary, non-governmental incorporated society (locally 'association of citizens') that acts on the territory of the Republic of Macedonia in accordance with applicable positive regulations.

Article 2

The Society operates under the name "Makedonsko Heraldicko Zdruzenie". The name of the Society in English would be "MACEDONIAN HERALDRDY SOCIETY".

Article 3

The Macedonian Heraldry Society (hereafter 'the Society') is a legal entity with rights, obligations and responsibilities stipulated by the Constitution, the Law and this Statute. The headquarters of the Society is in Skopje at following address: Petar Mandjukov 113 / 6.

Article 4

The Society has seal and stamp.

The seal features the words "Makedonsko Heraldicko Zdruzenie" around the Coat of Arms of the Society.

The stamp has imprinted text "Makedonsko Heraldicko Zdruzenie", number, date and place.

Article 5

The Coat of Arms of the Society shall be: On red field a silver hipokamp, which holds in the front legs crossed gold pen and herald's baton. Above the shield herald's crown. Behind the shield two crossed herald's batons.

The Coat of Arms can be represented in other heraldic presentations, medium, large, etc., as determined by policy.

Article 6

Objectives of the Society

- 1. Popularization of heraldry and related sciences and disciplines.
- 2. Research of the heraldic heritage of the Republic of Macedonia.
- 3. Recommendation and design of arms, flags, decorations.
- 4. Establishing heraldic register that will catalogue old and new arms, as well as any updates of existing arms.
- 5. Education in the field of heraldry and related sciences and disciplines.
- 6. Publishing works on heraldry and related sciences and disciplines.

Under related sciences and disciplines we consider the following: genealogy, vexillology, sphragistics, phaeleristics, nobility and chivlaristic issues.

Article 7

- The objectives of the previous article, among other things, are accomplished through:
- Organizing workshops, seminars, panel discussions and lectures.
- Publication of printed materials, magazines, books, brochures, copyright and translations.
- Establishing sections related sciences and disciplines: genealogy, vexillology, sphragistics, phaeleristics, nobility and chivlaristic issues.
- Establishing a Library

STATUTES AND CONSTITUTION

The FIAV provisional council adopted provisional statutes on September 3, 1967. The FIAV statutes were formally adopted on September 7, 1969 and amended on September 29, 1983. The statutes were replaced by the current FIAV Constitution, which was adopted on September 27, 1989. The Constitution has been amended on August 12, 1997, July 29, 1999, July 23, 2001, and August 7, 2007.

The current text of the Constitution is set out below. It contains the exact text as adopted and amended.

The applicant shall submit a membership application, which must be

received by the Board no later than six months before the convening of the

- (2) The Board shall consider the application and make a recommendation to the General Assembly relative to the applicant and shall communicate that recommendation to the applicant and to existing Members not later than three months before the convening of the next session of the General Assembly.
- (3) The Board may recommend acceptance of the applicant as a Member, or may recommend rejection of the applicant.
- (4) The General Assembly at its next session shall vote on the application. An authorized representative of the applicant may appear at the session to represent its case. A rejected applicant has the right to reapply for membership at any later session of the General Assembly.
- (c) The Board and the General Assembly, in making their decisions about an applicant, shall have regard to the following:
 - (1) the existence of a written constitution and its provisions;
 - (2) the vexillological and non-vexillological activities of the applicant, including meetings, publications, and international relations;
 - in the case of an association, the number of its dues-paying members (minimum of five);
 - (4) registration of its members in International Congresses of Vexillology;
 - (5) the length of time it has existed; and
 - (6) the presence of an autochthonous and authorized representative of the applicant at the session of the General Assembly at which there is to be a vote on the application.
- Art. 8 (a) A Member voluntarily resigns if it does not send a delegate to three consecutive sessions of the General Assembly. The resignation is effective at the adjournment of the third consecutive session.
 - (b) A Member may voluntarily resign by writing to the President. The resignation is effective on the date of its receipt.
 - (c) FIAV cannot reject a Member's voluntary resignation.
- Art. 9 At its discretion, the Board may require a Member to furnish evidence of its continued qualification for membership under the terms set forth in article 7. On the basis of this evidence, the Board may make a recommendation to the General Assembly on the continuation of the membership of the association or institution. If the recommendation is made to remove a Member from FIAV, the Member in question must be notified at least three months in advance of the session of the General Assembly at which there is to be a vote on the matter. The Member shall be invited to present its defense before the General Assembly, but shall not participate in the vote on the matter.
- Art. 10 Each Member regulates its own affairs in complete freedom, limited only by the laws in effect in the territory where it functions. FIAV may not limit the rights of the Members in this respect.
- Art. 11 Members shall not undertake any activities contrary to the interests of FIAV.
- Art. 12 (a) FIAV may not act on behalf of its Members without their authorization expressed in the General Assembly. Members may not make commitments nor act on behalf of FIAV.
 - (b) Members may not hold international vexillological meetings outside of International Congresses of Vexillology. Notwithstanding this prohibition, a Member holding a vexillological meeting in any year in which no International Congress of Vexillology is held may invite participation by a Member from a contiguous country.

- Art. 13 The General Assembly may name as "Laureates of the Federation" persons who have made outstanding contributions to vexillology. The General Assembly may delegate this power to the Board. The status as a Laureate does not confer any right within FIAV.
 - IV. THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY
- Art. 14 (a) The General Assembly is composed of the Officers together with a delegate from each of the Members. Each delegate must present to the President written credentials from the Member represented. A Member may delegate any or all of its powers in writing to a delegate from any other Member or to an Officer.
 - (b) A session of the General Assembly is not constituted unless delegates of at least half of the Members are present, except as provided for in article 25.
 - (c) Each Member and each Officer is entitled to one vote in the General Assembly.
- Art. 15 Majorities in the General Assembly consist of the following fractions of those Members present and voting:
 - (a) A simple majority in the election of Officers. If more than two candidates stand for election for an Office and no candidate receives a simple majority, then the candidate with the least votes shall be eliminated from the next ballot, and so on.
 - (b) A simple majority for a motion to amend a motion under consideration, to proceed to the next item of business on the agenda, to defer consideration of a motion, to refer a motion to a Commission, to appeal a ruling of the chair, for a record vote, or to adjourn a session of the General Assembly.
 - (c) Two-thirds for all other motions.
 - (d) Three-quarters for amendments to the Constitution or dissolution of FIAV.
- Art. 16 The General Assembly:
 - (a) elects Officers;
 - (b) examines and approves the administration of the Board and the Commissions;
 - (c) examines all questions concerning FIAV and in particular the organization of the International Congresses of Vexillology;
 - (d) interprets the Constitution;
 - (e) names Laureates of the Federation pursuant to article 13 and awards such other distinctions as it deems appropriate to persons or institutions who have shown particular merit in the field of vexillology (this power may be delegated to the Board); and
 - (f) determines the amount and disposition of the annual dues, if any, to be paid by Members; and
 - (g) establishes such Commissions as it deems necessary and appoints Commissioners.
- Art. 17 The General Assembly holds a session at least once every two years, normally on the occasion of each International Congress of Vexillology. The Board convenes a session of the General Assembly. The Board must give notice of the agenda, including any amendments to the Constitution or motion to dissolve FIAV, to all Members at least three months in advance of the session.
- Art. 18 The General Assembly may be called into an emergency session if extraordinary conditions require this, as determined by the Board, or if three-quarters of the Members request this of the Board.

V. ADMINISTRATION

Art. 19

- (a) The administration of FIAV is entrusted to a Board which acts only by unanimous agreement. The Board is composed of three Officers: the President, the Secretary-General, and the Secretary-General for Congresses.
- (b) The Officers are elected at the end of each session of the General Assembly and serve until the election of the new Officers at the next session of the General Assembly. Consent of the candidates for election is required. The Officers are eligible for re-election.
- (c) The Secretary-General and the Secretary-General for Congresses must reside on different continents. The Secretary-General manages the Permanent Secretariat of FIAV and the Secretary-General for Congresses manages the Permanent Secretariat of the International Congresses of Vexillology. The Board is considered to be in continuous session, conducted by correspondence.
- (d) A vacancy on the Board occurs if an Officer dies, resigns, or lacks mental capacity under the laws where the Officer resides. Absence of an Officer at a session of the General Assembly creates a vacancy on the Board unless excused by the General Assembly. The resignation of an Officer must be received in writing by another Officer, or if no Officer remains, then by the organizer of the next International Congress of Vexillology. The resignation is effective on the date of its receipt. If a vacancy occurs, the position shall remain vacant and the duties of that Officer shall be performed by the remaining Officers. If no Officer remains to perform the duties of the Board, then the organizer of the next International Congress of Vexillology shall select an interim Secretary-General from among the Fellows of the Federation, if available, who shall have the limited authority to take those acts necessary to convene a session of the General Assembly pursuant to article 17 or 18 and preside until the General Assembly elects a presiding officer for the remainder of the session.


Art. 20 The Board:

- (a) manages the current affairs of FIAV and establishes the duties and obligations of its Officers;
- (b) issues directives which it considers necessary to the success of the activities of FIAV, including the International Congresses of Vexillology;
- (c) establishes such Commissions as it deems necessary and appoints Commissioners;
- (d) convenes sessions of the General Assembly pursuant to articles 17 and 18;
- (e) represents FIAV in its relations with other national and international institutions; and
- (f) manages membership procedures pursuant to article 7 and encourages vexillological associations and institutions to apply for FIAV membership.
- Art. 21 FIAV's assent to an agreement imposing a binding obligation on FIAV may only be given by a written document signed by all Officers. Current correspondence may be signed by any single Officer.
 - VI. LANGUAGES
- Art. 22 The official languages of FIAV and the International Congresses of Vexillology are English, French, German, and Spanish. Other languages may be used when appropriate.
 - VII. PUBLICATIONS
- Art. 23 (a) FIAV shall publish a newsletter concerning its activities at least once a year for the benefit of its Members, which may be freely reproduced. The General Assembly may initiate or authorize other publications.
 - (b) The Flag Bulletin (ISSN 0015-3370) is recognized as a journal for the publication of scientific articles in the field of vexillology.

VIII. SYMBOLS

Art. 24

(a) FIAV's flag is described as follows: "On a blue field, extending horizontally from hoist to fly, two yellow halyards forming two interlaced loops." The color blue is defined as Pantone Matching System U293 and the color yellow is defined as Pantone Matching System U123. The Flag is illustrated as follows:



(b) The General Assembly may initiate or authorize other symbols for FIAV.

IX. DISSOLUTION

Art. 25

- (a) A motion to dissolve FIAV may be considered only at a session of the General Assembly at which delegates of at least three-quarters of the Members are present.
- (b) Instead of sending a delegate, a Member may chose to submit to the President a written, notarized statement expressing that Member's vote in favor of, or in opposition to, the motion to dissolve. A Member that submits any such statement shall be considered present at the session for the purpose of determining that the session is constituted to consider a motion to dissolve.
- (c) The General Assembly establishes the terms of the dissolution.

FLAG INFORMATION CODE

The Flag Information Code was adopted on August 27, 1981. The code has been amended on July 5, 1995 and July 23, 2001. The current text of the code is set out below. It contains the exact text as adopted and amended.

FLAG INFORMATION CODE

Sec. 1 The Fédération internationale des associations vexillologiques (FIAV) adopts this Flag Information Code and encourages its use by FIAV Members, individual vexillologists, publishers, and others who study flags.

Sec. 2 The purposes of the Code are:

- (a) to allow basic information about flags to be recorded and transmitted concisely, accurately, and in a manner which (1) insofar as possible eliminates misunderstandings and (2) is both easy to learn and comprehensible to persons knowing different languages;
- to standardize knowledge of flags in order to facilitate comparative studies of flag characteristics;
- to provide a convenient system for researchers, publishers, and others to record, exchange, and publish information; and
- (d) to eliminate, insofar as possible, the confusion that exists in the terminology employed by governments and others to describe national flags and their use.

Sec. 3 FLAG COLORS

(a) The following abbreviations indicate flag colors:

R (red) 0 (orange) Υ (yellow) ٧ (green) В (blue) Ρ (purple) Ν (black) W (white) G (grey) Μ (brown) (gold) Au Ag (silver)

- (b) Colors other than those listed above are not abbreviated.
- (c) The following symbols indicate approximate color shades:

(light)(very light)(dark)(very dark)

(d) The use of a color description without a symbol indicates a medium, normal, or unknown shade of the color.

Sec. 4 FLAG PROPORTIONS

Flag proportions are indicated by a ratio. The first figure corresponds to the width of the flag, which is defined as the side normally attached to the pole or staff. The second figure corresponds to the length of the flag. A flag with a width of 3 units and a length of 5 units is written either 3:5 or 3x5.

Sec. 5 NATIONAL FLAG USE

(a) The following grid is used to describe the use or uses of a flag whose primary purpose is to identify nationality rather than some other characteristic (such as the rank of an individual, the existence of a specific government or military institution, or some other concept):

++

- (b) The six areas of the grid indicate the six basic uses of national flags: (1) use by private individuals and institutions on land; (2) use by nonmilitary governmental institutions on land; (3) use by military institutions on land; (4) use by private individuals and institutions at sea; (5) use by nonmilitary governmental institutions at sea; and (6) use by military institutions at sea. Private, nonmilitary governmental, and military use is indicated from left to right by the three vertical columns; use on land and at sea is indicated from top to bottom by the two horizontal rows.
- (c) The grid is written or printed in the line of identifying text near the flag illustration, together with the ratio indicating proportions. The use or uses of the flag are indicated by placing a point (•) or an × in the appropriate area or areas of the grid.
- Sec. 6 The flag information summarized by the Code is not a substitute for a specific textual description of a flag and its use or uses.
- Sec. 7 An amendment to the Code may be adopted only by the FIAV General Assembly. Before the General Assembly considers an amendment, the amendment should be discussed by individuals attending the International Congress of Vexillology during which the General Assembly session will be held. FIAV Members and individual vexillologists are encouraged to propose amendments based on their experience in using the Code.
