Dear Vexillologists and Friends,

It is a privilege for me to introduce this electronic documentation of the XVI International Congress for Vexillology¹, organized in Warsaw on July 1-5th 1995.

The very long preparations to have this Congress in the Capital City of Poland, I envisaged in the early spring of 1993. My friends from the new established (1992) Polish Vexillological Society - Andrzej Bebłowski, Andrzej Bonasewicz, Leszek Hołdanowicz² and Alfred Znamierowski declared the importance of this project for future development of the new science in Poland.

On the international arena, I had a great support to continue with the idea to have ICV in Poland from the most creative artists. I am working with them in the Earth Flag Center, since its foundation in 1978 as the private-independent and creative center. I wish to underline here the name Leif Jonsson from Stiftelsen Lako Institutet in Sweden, and our project “Flaggor fran falntag till folkfest” where the Earth Flag Collection has been displayed with the presence of two original geovexillolographers from Poland - prof. Lech Majewski and prof. Roslaw Szaybo.

It was a great honor for me, that during the XV International Congress of Vexillology in Zurich, August 23rd – 27th 1993 I could, as the newcomer to FIAV Congress, to present Poland as a candidate country and Warsaw as the perspective location for 16th ICV.

I remember very well the candidate competition proceedings in Zurich ICV. Then, with the positive and constructive votes by FIAV members, the historical and emotional moment when Dr Emil Dreyer, FIAV Secretary-General, handed me over the ceremonial insignia of world vexillological family: the FIAV flag and the engraved gavel. I carried them back to Warsaw proudly, as a token of vexillologists trust, two years before their visit to XVI ICV.

Following my declaration in Zurich I wanted with the Polish Vexillological Society and the Flag Design Center to present ICV in Warsaw as big and reach as possible. Having this in mind Earth Flag Center joined the preparation of celebration the 700th anniversary of the Polish Emblem.

¹ As ICV has to promote vexillology in the given country, Warsaw's organizers decided to call *International Congress for Vexillology* instead of Vexillology.

² Designer of the flag commemorating the XVI ICV and the celebrations of 700 years of the White Eagle – the Emblem of Poland. This flag, in one copy only, after the presentation during XV ICV in Zurich in 1993, was deposited in the Royal Castle in Warsaw; hoisted once during the state ceremony of the Royal Castle Tower, June 26th 1995, by Polish actor – Daniel Olbrychski; documentation on a TV film, emission November 11th 1995.

For many historians June 26th 1295, the coronation of the Piast duke Przemyslaw II, was an important date that marked the honorable insignia of the Polish Kingdom and the adoption of the White Eagle on a red field, the royal seal and the flag of the Kingdom of Poland became such symbols.

I declared that to find the important and respective partners is the only one objective to have a good International Congress for Vexillology. Then, flags will be flown in various parts of Polish capital and the congress will hold its open debate in Art Center Studio in the metropolitan Palace of Culture and Science. Museums, galleries, libraries, churches, Embassies of Sweden and Slovakia, the French and the German cultural institutes, the Polish Post, the editorial board of “Życie Warszawy” daily and Polish Airport Authority took part in the congress program.

I would wish to share, that the XVI International Congress for Vexillology in Warsaw had a honorary patronage of the Speaker of Polish Parliament. In the Earth Flag Center archives there are several letters related to the formal invitation to 16th ICV Patron. H. E. Mr. Józef Oleksy accepted on February 2nd 1994 to act as the Honorary Patron of ICV’95. When H. E. Mr. Józef Oleksy became the Prime Minister of Poland, the following Speaker of the Polish Parliament – H. E. Mr. Józef Zych notified on May 23rd 1994 that kindly accepts to keep his Honorary Patronage on 16th ICV.

For the opening of the 16th ICV – H. E. Mr. Józef Zych wrote a letter to Mr. Władysław Serwatowski, acting as President of XVI ICV, on June 29th 1995, congratulating the international vexillological community to celebrate with the ICV the 700th anniversary of the adoption of the Polish Emblem and with very good wishes for the future development of vexillology – science promoting the best civilization traditions and a good historical knowledge.

The very unique position of the 16th ICV on daily events in Poland, in mass-media and in public opinion was the result of the global solidarity of the institutions worked together for. Apart from the Museums, Galleries, Churches Hotels, City Halls, Airport Terminal and Warsaw University as organizers of the vexillological week in Poland I wish to underline the financial support for ICV by distinguished benefactors, donors and sponsors.

Eight years after, this disc contains all presentations provided by congressmen to Earth Flag Center. Some diskettes were seriously infected, other unreadable by nowadays computer.

As the editor I apologize for the inconvenience and hope that the Authors of the absent presentations are able to update this document on their own way
