1. Call to Order by the President; official opening of the Twenty-Seventh Session

The President, wielding the FIAV Gavel, called the meeting to order at 15h42 on 12 July 2022 at the Conference Venue, Hotel Slon, Ljubljana, Slovenia and officially opened the Twenty-Seventh Session of the General Assembly of the Fédération international des associations vexillologiques (FIAV).

Roll call of delegates and recognition of quorum by the Secretary-General; declaration by the President that the Twenty-Seventh Session of the General Assembly is constituted

The SG called the roll as indicated above.

Members present (40): AAV, ACV, BHVS, CBFA, CFA, CEBED, CIDEC, CISV, CVS, CONAVEX, DGF, FHF, FI, FOTW, FRC, FSA, GSI, GWAV, HS, HGZD, JAVA, KVV, MGD, NAVA, NEVA, NVVV, NZFA, PTW, PFA, SAVA, SCHG, SEV, SFV, SSV, SVB, SVI, UHT, VAST, VRCC and WVRI.

Members absent (11): BS, BDA, HVK, IVA, IHW, MZT, NF, PH, RCVH, SGHAPG and SVPR.

FIAV Officers Present (3): Dr. Željko Heimer – President; Dr. Bruce Berry – Secretary-General (SG); and Mr. Graham Bartram – Secretary-General for Congresses (SGC).

The SG determined that 40 of the 51 Members were present which satisfies Article 14(b) constitutional requirement that delegates of at least half of the Members be present. The SG recognized the presence of a quorum and the President formally declared the Twenty-Seventh Session of the General Assembly was properly constituted.

The SG distributed voting cards to the accredited delegates and the FIAV Officers.

In terms of the voting requirements outlined in Article 15 of the Constitution, as published in *Info-FIAV* No. 39, the SG confirmed that a simple majority vote would require 21 votes, a two-thirds majority vote would require 27 votes and a three-fourths majority vote would require 30 votes.

4. Appointment by the President of Tellers to count votes

The President appointed Anže Hobĭc and Kryštof Huk to count the votes.

5. Approval of the Minutes of the Twenty-Sixth Session of the General Assembly held on 16 July 2019 in San Antonio (Texas), United States

Moved by SSV; seconded by AAV, "That the Minutes of the Twenty-Sixth Session of the General Assembly, as published in *Info-FIAV* No. 50 (December 2019) on pages 1 to 58 be approved". Passed by two-thirds majority.

6. Reports by the Board

(a) President Dr. Željko Heimer

My dear Secretaries-General, Bruce and Graham, Dear delegates of the Twenty-Seventh Session of the FIAV General Assembly, Dear guests, ladies and gentlemen,

It has been three full years since we last met in what was now an entirely different world. When we convened in San Antonio, Texas, and when we took the offices, nobody in their wildest dreams could have envisioned what would happen to the world, less than a year afterwards. An International Congress of Vexillology, and thus also a FIAV General Assembly, had never been postponed before, nor has it ever been so long between two presidential reports!

It had been wild ride for all of us since Texas and I hope that we shall be able to soon be able to look back at these events that I hope never will be repeated. However, we are still living in that crazy world today and it does not look like we will return to 'normal' anytime soon. To paraphrase the wisest wizard I know of: "I wish it need not have happened in my time... and so do all who live to see such times. But that is not for them to decide. All we have to decide is what to do with the time that is given us."

The FIAV Board has been working hard and diligently throughout these difficult times. Although we even had plans to meet in person in Ljubljana a year prior to the congress, things got difficult just as we were finalizing those plans and unfortunately, we were unable to meet in person. On the other hand, however, the use of video-conferencing technology that bloomed during this period enabled us to meet virtually more often than if we had only met live. We have had regular Zoom calls and emails to stay in touch since San Antonio.

But, let us take a step back and see what we did. Upon return from Texas, there was much to do within the organisation itself and to ensure a smooth transition between past president and secretary-general and the new ones. There were also many minor points to cover and so much consultation occurred and I was happy to jump in as much as possible to ease the process. Charles Spain, our esteemed former Secretary-General, had led the operations of the organisation for 22 years and there was so much we needed to get from him that I think we were soon probably getting on his nerves for not allowing him to finally enjoy his well deserved "retirement" as Secretary-General Emeritus. I am very grateful for his help and patience with us.

The election of the FIAV President from Croatia was widely covered in Croatian national media. This information and an interview with me was published by the Croatian national news agency (HINA) on 17 August 2019 and relayed by various other national media

sources. Of course, the details of the election of the new FIAV Board was also published in numerous vexillological journals around the world.

As newly elected President I decided to fulfill a long-promised pledge to visit Skopje, Northern Macedonia in October 2019. I was hosted there by the small, but vigorous, Macedonian Heraldic Society, who organized no less than three lectures for me to deliver in two days. These were for students of the Faculty of Law of the University in Skopje, for the Jewish Community in Macedonia and for the host society itself. I was hoping that I would be able to maintain a pace of such visits, at least in the immediate wider region every few months but alas, for the reasons we are all well aware of, that was my last journey in person to a vexillological event until now.

In February 2020 the virus that was first detected in Wuhan soon spread into a pandemic and reached Europe. Just as the first weekend of national isolation was proclaimed in Zagreb – we got hit by another disaster – an earthquake such as had not been seen in Zagreb for 150 years hit the center of the city. While it wasn't particularly strong as earthquakes around the world go – the old city of Zagreb was not build to withstand such tremors and it has been a difficult period clearing up destroyed buildings and infrastructure from which we have not yet fully recovered.. And while we were slowly recovering, living in isolation, on the New Year's Eve in 2019 another, even stronger earthquake, hit us again some 50 km south of Zagreb, destroying towns and villages and adding more devastation to the still unrepaired buildings in Zagreb itself.

All bets were suddenly off... Initially we all hoped that the pandemic would be over in a month or two and that we could have a FIAV Board meeting in May 2020 in Ljubljana as we originally planned. As the months went by it became clear that it was not going to happen. A vexillological seminar in Stockholm, Sweden, planned for the end of May 2020, for which I even purchased plane tickets just a few days before the earthquake/Covid crises, was cancelled, but this was just the beginning ...

Our social lives also soon moved into cyberspace and the first national vexillological event that was held this way, that I attended, was the 54th NAVA annual meeting hosted in virtual meeting room of the US Library of Congress in June 2020.

The next was the 7th Czech National Vexillological Congress in September 2020 – held partly live with a video link for participants. I had the distinct pleasure to join the delegates in Frýdek-Místek and to greet them in Czech. The Flag Institute followed with a yearlong series of events to celebrate their Golden Jubilee – starting on 23 April 2021, coinciding with my 50th birthday, where they kindly let me talk on Zoom on some parallels of the Institute's and my own life's events. I also joined the virtual auditorium for several of the FI events that followed.

In September 2021, I once again joined by Zoom the 26th Italian National Vexillological Meeting held in Brescia, greeting the meeting in the my 'best' Italian and where I was honored with the title of honorary member of CISV. Once again, "Grazie".

For the 2021 World Vexillology Day on 1 October, initiated in 2016 and recognized by FIAV in 2017, I gave an in-person lecture to the 6th Croatian National Congress of History on the international activities of HGZD and also marking the 15th anniversary of the Croatian association. I also repeated my lecture on the vexillological history of Rijeka I gave in San Antonio, Texas. At the end of 2021 I was invited to provide an introductory address to the participants of the First Flag Suppliers Seminar organized by the Vexillological Research Center of China.

As the FIAV President, I also gave interviews to various vexillological publications as well as to general media. Thus, Flagmaster 160 in 2020 published an interview with me as well as did *Vexil·la Catalana* number 1 Epoca 3 in 2021. I was interviewed for the German global TV news station *Deutsche Welle* in July 2020 in regard with the flag change issue in Mississippi and on Croatian national TV regarding flag use in Belarus in August 2020.

One of the tasks that the new FIAV board took seriously was the maintenance and updating of the FIAV web site. We decided that on this platform we needed to publish the papers from the ICV proceedings published so far. This was added to the FIAV Constitution several years ago as a requirement for the subsequent congresses, but for the previous congresses, we had to obtain permission from the copyright holders and we had to locate copies of the proceedings – some of which proved to be quite rare, then to have them digitalized and finally put them on-line. I'm very grateful to Emil Dreyer and Ted Kaye who helped locate some of the scarcest proceedings, but most of all we are indebted to Steven A. Knowlton, who already started the project a few years ago, who joined us to augment the FIAV web site. At the moment of all published proceedings from 20 ICVs are available on the website and the outstanding six shall hopefully be added soon, pending formal permission from the publisher.

Even if the summer of 2020 gave us hope that things would improve, the Board and organisers in Ljubljana were still convinced that we would be able to keep the ICV dates as planned in 2021, the autumn showed us wrong. Heraldica Slovenica was reluctant to postpone the Congress and so were we, and we determined not to call it a day until we saw what the spring would bring. The Covid-19 Restrictions only got tighter, even if vaccinations provided hope for a quick cure. We were postponing the final cut-off date almost every week, but, alas, by March 2021 we had to take the decision. Based on the continued restrictions and lack of mobility, especially between regions and countries, decided we had to move the ICV 29 back by one year - and that it would mean moving all subsequent congresses to now be held on the even years. It wasn't an easy decision and we tried to consult with as many as we could and to reconcile various views. We are aware that we could not please everyone, but we are convinced that we have made the best choice within the circumstances and I hope we shall be proved right as time goes by. So, we started planning all anew for 2022 – and here we are today. I would like to thank you all, and in particular the organisers, Heraldica Slovenica, for your understanding and co-operation.

On a personal note, in 2019 I took the office of Herold of the Brethren of Croatian Dragon Society, a cultural heritage association established in 1905 honoring meritorious people and events from history and devoted to preserving Croatian cultural heritage. This civic organisation began the tradition of granting arms to its members, and continued to do so until 1946, when it was banned by the new regime. It was re-established in 1990 and it is now one of three domains granting new coats of arms in Croatia – the other two being the Roman Catholic Church for its priests and the Ministry of Administration approving arms to municipalities. The so called 'draconian heraldry', although being limited to the society members, forms an important part of Croatian heraldic heritage. Furthermore, in summer 2021, I was also elected to the governing body of that association in the office of Master of Ceremonies. This has given me a new perspective on heraldry and vexillology, and on its social significance and dynamics.

While I patiently awaited the outcome of the 'third wave', just as we were hoping to end all the Covid-19 restrictions, we got to experience the ultimate plague – war broke out in Europe of such proportions as we have not witnessed in more than seven decades! Yes, of course, we've seen wars in the former Yugoslavia thirty years ago, but this was something entirely different and ominous shadows glimmered over the European sky.

But as we are gathered here today, it means that these events are not going to stop us and that a new and exciting future awaits us. I follow with joy the news of the various vexillological activities taking place around the world. I'm especially fond of news reaching me on new vexillological societies being formed all over the globe. I welcome the various new applicants for FIAV membership and am aware of several more that were planning to join us at this meeting. Our forefathers six decades ago, when organizing their first publications and preparing for international meetings and sowing the seeds of vexillology around the globe, would be astonished to see how far we have come.

But we are just as aware that there is so much more in vexillology to study, so... keep studying those flags and continue with all the good work!

(b) Secretary General, Dr. Bruce Berry

Good afternoon and welcome to delegates, friends and fellow vexillologists.

As outlined by our esteemed President, together we have all experienced some turbulent times since our last meeting in San Antonio in 2019, so it is indeed a pleasure to be able to welcome you all here this evening. On behalf of the Board, I would like to express our condolences to any those present who may have lost loved ones or friends as a result of Covid-19 and the subsequent lockdowns.

The lockdowns which were instituted across the world resulted in a "new world of work" for many and FIAV was no exception. Like many others, we were forced to adapt and to utilize technology in the form of Zoom and Teams in order to remain in touch and to conduct our business. The Board thus "met" virtually on a number of occasions, both amongst ourselves, with the Congress organisers and with our back-up support, to ensure that things continued to operate smoothly.

Special mention must go to my fellow Board members who had to put up with my nagging emails, meeting requests and the like. It had been our intention to meet in person before the Congress in 2021, but the pandemic and subsequent travel restrictions introduced during 2020 meant that was not possible. Nonetheless, our virtual meetings have been frank and entertaining, with all decisions being arrived at by consensus.

As the new Secretary-General, I would like at this point to particularly thank my processor, Charles ("Kin") Spain for having left the affairs of FIAV in exceptionally good order such that the transition and hand-over has been smooth and uneventful. My initial focus was therefore to ensure that I got to grips with the admin etc and the Info-FIAVs went out as required. So, a heartfelt "thank you" to Charles for a job well done.

Six issues of *Info-FIAV* (numbers 50, 51, 52, 53, 54 and 55) were published since the last GA, two dealing specifically with the decision of the Board to postpone the holding of the ICV in 2021 and with the subsequent arrangements for this, and future, Congresses.

By way of correspondence, understandably, most of the queries I received were in respect of the Congress arrangements. There were also inquiries from potential new members as well as some feedback and comment on the various *Info-FIAVs*.

Other matters attended to related to the maintenance and updating of the website. As Željko has already mentioned, efforts to secure a comprehensive record of all the ICV proceedings continued and there were also some refinements to the layout, look and feel of fiav.org.

Should any members have any other suggestions regarding the administration, please don't hesitate to let me know.

Thank you all for your attention and I look forward to a successful meeting.

(c) Secretary-General for Congresses – Mr. Graham Bartram

I would like to give special mention to the organisers of this ICV, Heraldica Slovenica. With the decision to postpone the Congress from 2020 to 2021, this resulted in the Organising Team having to spend additional time to reschedule and reorganise matters. On behalf of FIAV, I would like to thank them for their patience, dedication and hard work to ensure that we have a successful Congress.

I am pleased to report that the proceedings from ICV 26 that was held in Sydney in 2015 have published and distributed to all the participants. The proceedings from London are expected to be published by the end of the year.

Regarding future Congresses, the Vexillological Research Center of China are organizing ICV 30 in Beijing in August 2024. This will be our second ICV to be held in Asia, after ICV in Yokohama in 2009. At this General Assembly, we have to take a decision on the hosting of ICV 31. The Société française de vexillologie has asked to host ICV 31 in Paris in 2026.

I am happy to discuss organizing a Congress with any FIAV member, and of course, there is lots of time to prepare. There are plenty of organisations out there that were created specifically to bring a Congress or conference to their particular country or city. Often the help provided is given free of charge. If anyone is thinking of organsing a Congress, it is suggested that you consider using them.

Finally, I would like to thank my fellow Board members, Željko and Bruce, for their help and support over the last three years. It makes a lot of difference to how difficult this job it is to do this job if you have colleagues who you can get on with, and I believe we have made a good team.

(b) Member Applicant Presentations

As outlined in Article 7(b), as amended, of the Constitution, "an authorized representative of the applicant must appear at the Session to present its case". Presentations were heard from LIGH, THVA and VSS.

No representative from VAHK was present and therefore its application was not considered.

(c) Elections

It was moved by NAVA and seconded by SGC that all three applications for membership of FIAV be considered together.

The motion was passed by two-thirds majority, with two abstentions, thereby increasing the total number of current FIAV members to 54.

The President recognized the LIGH delegate, Mr. Remigijus Bimba; THVA's delegate, Dr. Attila István Szekeres and VSS's delegate, Dr. Emil Dreyer, who were given seats in the General Assembly.

As a result, the number of Members present increased to 43, increasing the number of votes to 46 (including the 3 Officers present). With the admission of the new Members, a simple majority would require 24 votes, a two-thirds majority vote would require 31 votes and a three-fourths majority vote would require 35 votes.

The SC distributed voting cards to the accredited delegates of the new Members.

8) Election of the 2022-2024 Board

Candidates for the FIAV Board

- (i) President:
 - Željko Heimer announced his candidacy for re-election.
- (ii) Secretary-General:
 - Bruce Berry announced his candidacy for re-election.
- (iii) Secretary-General for Congresses:
 Graham Bartram announced his candidacy for re-election.

It was moved by NAVA, seconded by FRC, that all the Board candidates be re-elected.

The motion was passed by simple majority, with three abstentions, thereby re-electing the current Board members until 2024.

9) Report on ICV 20 (Beijing, 2024)

The next ICV will be hosted by VRCC and FRC in Beijing, China, between 12-19 August 2024. The Congress flag and emblem were unveiled and an overview of the venues and proposed tours was provided. The language of the Congress will be English with Chinese translations. Further details about the accommodation and prices etc. will be announced in due course.

10) Report on the status of ICV Proceedings

- (a) ICV 26 (Sydney 2015) organized by FSA. Published in 2022.
- (b) ICV 27 (London 2017) organized by FI. Editing being finalized and publication is expected before the end of 2022.
- (c) ICV 28 (San Antonio, 2019) organized by VAST and FRC. Not yet published.

11) Presentation of Certificates to current Members that have been ICV Organisers if publication of the Proceedings has occurred.

Certificates were presented to FSA for the publication of the Proceedings of ICV 26 held in Sydney, Australia, in 2015 at the Closing Banquet.

12) Selection of ICV 31 (2026) organiser

Moved by the SG, seconded by HGZD, that "Société française de vexillologie (SFV) be selected as the organisers for ICV 31 to be held in Paris in 2026.

Motion passed by simple majority, with no abstentions.

13) Canvas of Members that did not send a delegate for purposes of Constitution article 8

The SG confirmed that the following members did not send a delegate to the Twenty-seventh Session of the General Assembly: BS, BDA, HVK, IVA, IHW, MZT, NF, PH, RCVH, SGHAPG and SVPR.

Members without delegates for three consecutive Sessions: MZT. This member will voluntarily resign as a Member effective at the adjournment of this Session.

Members without delegates for two consecutive Sessions: NF, PH, HVK and RCVH. If these members do not send a delegate to the Twenty-Eight Session of the General Assembly, they will voluntarily resign as Members effective at the adjournment of the Twenty-Eighth Session in 2026.

Members without delegates for only one General Assembly Session were: BS, BDA, IVA, IHW, SGHAPG and SVPR.

14) Final adjournment

A motion proposed by WVRI, seconded by UHT, to add a further point to agenda was not carried. This item to be considered at the next meeting of the GA.

There being no further business, the President adjourned the Twenty-Seventh Session of the General Assembly at 17h20.



The following FIAV Board actions are relevant to the Members list:

- 2016–3 Members are identified by names in the language or languages which the Members specified when they joined FIAV, and Member names are not otherwise translated. To simplify discussions in the General Assembly and in *Info-FIAV*, Members may be identified by abbreviations assigned by the Secretary-General.
- 2016–5 Members should notify the Secretary-General of any substantive changes in status, i.e., a change of name, territory, or anything affecting the basic membership requirements set out in Constitution articles 6 and 7(a). The Secretary-General will communicate any such change in status to the General Assembly, which may take action as it deems appropriate.
- Board Action 2016–4 is amended to read as follows: The territory of Members is listed to reflect the geographic status under which each Member was admitted to FIAV. Four Members were admitted as having a territory containing more than one country: GSI, NF, NAVA, and SAVA. FOTW was admitted as a Member with the understanding that its territory would correspond to the country in which its director resides (see *Info-FIAV* number 19, page 22 (2001)). A Member's territory is relevant for determining the effect of FIAV Constitution article 12(b). The Board will communicate unresolved issues regarding FIAV Constitution article 12(b) to the General Assembly, which may take action as it deems appropriate.

A Member's address is generally listed given in the standard format of the addressee's country, except in this list all country names are given in English. Information on standard address formats is available on the Universal Postal Union's web site at www.upu.int.
